



The City of West Des Moines will host the 2017 Solheim Cup at the Des Moines Golf and Country Club from August 14 – 20, 2017.

Due to increased traffic in the area, Jordan Creek Parkway from University Avenue to Lake Drive will be closed for the duration of the event. Barricades will be placed at the intersections of University Avenue and Lake Drive.

Please note the following changes to traffic patterns during this closure:

- Vehicles headed north on Jordan Creek Parkway will be required to turn right onto Lake Drive, which will be a one-way eastbound road. As a note, when returning to Jordan Creek Parkway, you cannot use Lake Drive, as you are unable to turn left. Drivers are advised to use 60th street to return to Jordan Creek Parkway.
- Traffic coming from I-80 will be required to turn right onto Lake Drive. As a note, when returning to I-80, you cannot use Lake Drive, as you are unable to turn left. Drivers are advised to use 60th street to access I-80 West and 50th street to access I-235.
- University Avenue will remain open, and cars will be allowed to turn south onto 71st, 68th and 60th Streets.
- Vehicles not traveling to the golf course are encouraged to use the 50th and 60th Street exits or the Grand Prairie Parkway exit to access University Avenue.


All businesses and locations east of the golf course, including DMOS Orthopaedic Centers, will be accessible to the public. Heavy traffic is expected Thursday and Friday during morning commutes to work as well as after 10 p.m. on Friday and Saturday.

Please plan your route in advance and be prepared for delays, especially during peak travel times.
